TO THE BIBLE - 1 John 4:10-11

"In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins. Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love one another."

LET'S TALK



The Bible says, *"For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life"* (John 3:16). Isn't it remarkable that the Bible doesn't say *"For God so loved Christians that He gave His only begotten son..."* Rather, it says *"For God so loved the world,"* and that doesn't refer to the plants, trees, and other physical features in the world, but to the world of men—sinners! What could God have seen in these sinners who didn't even want Him that would compel Him to offer the ultimate sacrifice—the death of His Son—to save them?

This lets me know that God loves everybody, irrespective of who they are and what they've done. In His eyes, everyone is beautiful; there's a value in man that makes God love him unconditionally. That love causes Him to look beyond your shortcomings. The Bible says *"...that is, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not imputing their trespasses to them..."* (2 Corinthians 5:19).

God's love for man is both unconditional and irrevocable. In Ephesians 5:1, we're admonished to be imitators of God as beloved children. This includes how you treat classmates, siblings, teammates, and even people who offend you. There's a beauty in others that God expects you to see, irrespective of what you see and how you may feel about them.

When you train yourself to relate with everyone around you in this manner, anger, malice, and bitterness will never be a part of your life! There wouldn't be anything that someone could do that would make you want to hurt or hate them. Rather, you'd respond to people with the love of God. Let God's love burn in you, such that you'll always see the good in others. Let there be absolutely nobody that you can't love, for everyone is lovable. I love everybody because I see them with the eyes of the Father. Remember, everyone is lovable, for they're all worth the blood of God's own Son.

THE POWER OF A FILTERED MOUTH

(Build Your Life with Your Words)

TO THE BIBLE - Matthew 12:36-37

"But I say to you that for every idle word men may speak, they will give account of it in the day of judgment. For by your words you will be justified, and by your words you will be condemned."

LET'S TALK



In the realm of the spirit, words are extremely important. Many young people speak negatively about themselves without realising it—about their intelligence, future, family, or abilities. That's why the Lord Jesus said, "...by your words you will be justified, and by your words you will be condemned." Interpreting the Master's words literally means that a man will go to heaven or hell because of what he said or didn't say. But beyond that, your life is the character of your words. If a man's words are confusing, his life will be confusing. In the same way, if a man's words are wholesome, his life will be wholesome.

This is why you must watch what you say. Some folks are positive with their "mouth-work" at times, and negative at other times; that's the reason they experience so many ups and downs in their lives. Having made a wrong confession, they'd say: "I didn't really mean what I said," or "I was only joking when I said that." Well, in the realm of the spirit, you have what you say, whether or not you meant it. In Mark 11:23, Jesus didn't say, "...you shall have what you mean;" He said, "...*you shall have what you say.*"

If you must make any joke, let it be positive and don't joke against the Word. Avoid making self-deprecating jokes or "venting" about how you're "dead" or "finished" after a

long day. Don't make careless statements, for they'll produce results for you. That's why you must say only what you mean, and mean whatever you say.

Remember, God holds you accountable for the things you say. So, build your life with your words. Your life can't be different from the words you speak. Therefore, make it a conscious exercise to store God's Word in your heart, for out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks (Matthew 12:34). As God's Word dwells richly in your heart, you'll develop and speak faith-filled words. Praise God!

LET'S TALK



Engineers have long dreamed of creating a truly universal remote control that can operate every device regardless of brand, model, or age. The challenge is that different systems use different frequencies, protocols, and codes. Yet, in the realm of the spirit, there exists a "Master Code" that works on every problem, whether it's physical, emotional, relational, or financial—the Name of Jesus!

The Bible tells us that Peter and John encountered a man who was lame from birth at the gate of the temple called Beautiful. Yet, when Peter said to the man, *"In the Name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, rise up and walk,"* life came into those dead limbs, and the man leapt and walked! If Peter had shouted, *"In the name of Caesar, rise up and walk!"* nothing would have happened. If he had yelled as loud as he could, *"In the name of Pontius Pilate, rise up and walk,"* nothing would have happened either. It had to be *"In the Name of Jesus,"* for that's the Name that's above every name; that's the Name that unlocks every door! Hallelujah!

No matter the critical situation in which you've found yourself, you can use the Name of Jesus to effect a change. Maybe it feels like failing an important exam, being left out by your friends, battling anxiety before a presentation,

or dealing with online bullying. It may be impossible for you on your own to get out of that negative situation, just like the crippled man at the gate couldn't walk by his own ability, but through the power in the Name of Jesus, you can walk out of any trouble. All you need to do is call that Name in faith, and you'll walk out of fear, anxiety, depression, and failure.

The Name of Jesus is the Name you can trust; it's the name that never fails! By the power of that name, I prophesy to you today: you're walking out of that difficulty. If you've been sick, I pronounce you healed! If you couldn't walk, begin to walk! I declare success, promotion, increase, and prosperity for you, in the mighty Name of Jesus! Whatever you couldn't do before, do it now, in the all-powerful Name of Jesus! Glory to God!

TO THE BIBLE - John 14:9

"Jesus said to him, 'Have I been with you so long, and yet you have not known Me, Philip? He who has seen Me has seen the Father; so how can you say, 'Show us the Father'?"

LET'S TALK



Many young people hear adults say, "God works in mysterious ways," and start thinking God is unpredictable or hard to understand, like someone who changes rules without warning. But God isn't that way; He's not mysterious at all. Jesus showed us clearly what the Father is really like.

Jesus proved that God isn't mysterious when He said, *"He who has seen Me has seen the Father."* In other words, if you want to know what the Father is like, just look at Jesus. The Bible describes Jesus as the brightness of God's glory, and the express image of His person (Hebrews 1:3), and Jesus wasn't mysterious at all!

To be mysterious is to be strange and unpredictable, and Jesus wasn't that way. He was, and still is, the perfect representation of the Father's personality. He's the Word of God made flesh. Thus, if you want to know more about the Father, then dig into the Word of God! Instead of guessing what God is like based on random opinions, social media quotes, or what someone angrily says during a crisis, study the Word daily, and you'll become better acquainted with the Father's personality. As you receive His Word into your Spirit and meditate on it, His character will be revealed to you and through you.

Make up your mind to know the Lord; He's a loving,

caring, thoughtful, patient, and merciful Father! A loving person can never be mysterious. Contrary to the perception of many, God isn't the one responsible for the things that cause grief, turmoil, and panic in the world; those are the acts of the devil. According to the Bible, only good and perfect things come from God (James 1:17).

So, don't be deceived by ignorant folks who attribute every disaster and chaos in the world to God. He's a God of love who is more than willing to reveal Himself to His kids. He doesn't want anyone in the dark regarding His personality; that's why He gave us His Word and sent the Holy Spirit to show us who He is. Praise God!

WALK ON WATER

(Keep Your Eyes on the Word)

TO THE BIBLE - Matthew 14:29-31

"So He said, 'Come.' And when Peter had come down out of the boat, he walked on the water to go to Jesus. But when he saw that the wind was boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink he cried out, saying, 'Lord, save me!' And immediately Jesus stretched out His hand and caught him, and said to him, 'O you of little faith, why did you doubt?'"

LET'S TALK



One night, the disciples of Jesus were in a boat, far out at sea, and suddenly, they saw someone walking towards them on the water. Terrified, they thought it was a ghost, but it turned out to be the Master Himself. One of them, Simon Peter, dared to say, *"Lord, if it's you, ask me to come to you on the water."* Interestingly, Jesus didn't say, "No! Walking on water requires lots of prayerfulness, boy!" Rather, He spoke one word to Peter, *"Come!"* Peter jumped out of the boat and began walking on the water to Jesus.

But something happened next that changed the course of the story. Peter looked at the raging winds, and immediately, he began to sink. The question is: What was the connection between fear and the water? Why did the water—which, up until that time, had held him up—suddenly give way beneath his feet? Notice that as the Master quickly reached out to save Peter, He didn't say, "Oh Peter, you stepped on the wrong spot;" instead, He asked him, *"Why did you doubt?"* It was doubt that deactivated the power of the word "Come," which Jesus had spoken to him.

If Peter hadn't doubted, the water would have held him up as perfectly as it did Jesus. Just like Peter, many young people often start strong in faith but get distracted by pressure, fear, or opinions. That shouldn't be you. Never

allow doubt to creep into your heart. Doubt breeds fear, and fear is of the devil. Doubt has robbed many of the opportunity to function at the level God has called them into. Build absolute confidence in the Word of God, for it never fails. All that Peter and the other disciples needed was the Word "Come," spoken by the Master, and they all could have walked and danced on that water.

Learn to keep your attention fully on what the Word of God says, and you'll never be overwhelmed by the circumstances of life. When group chats are buzzing with panic before a test, when everyone says, "This is impossible," or when your own thoughts try to talk you out of believing big, choose to focus on what God has said instead. The same situations that challenge others will be your platform for victories. God's Word is trustworthy and dependable; so believe it with all your heart and refuse to doubt.

LET'S TALK



Emma: "Honestly, I feel like I just have to try things for myself, even if something goes wrong."

Lena: "But what if you don't have to take the longest route just to find your way?"

Emma: "So... you're saying there's a better way?"

Lena: "Yeah. God's Word. It guides you before the mistake ever happens."

Many young people assume they must make mistakes first before learning important lessons, but God's Word was given so you don't have to learn the hard way. It's the instruction manual for living. That's why the Bible says, *"All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness"* (2 Timothy 3:16). TO THE BIBLE - 1 Corinthians 6:15

"Do you not know that your bodies are members of Christ?..."

LET'S TALK



Physicists have discovered a strange phenomenon called quantum entanglement, where two particles become so deeply connected that they behave as one system, even when separated by vast distances.

Our opening scripture above alludes to this concept, albeit at a much more advanced, spiritual level. It shows us that it isn't just our spirits that are joined to the Body of Christ; even our very bodies are part of Him! Notice the Apostle Paul didn't say, "Your body is a member of Christ," which would have led us to believe he was speaking in a generic sense; he said, "...your bodies are members of Christ," meaning your own body—yes, the one you use every day—is part of Him.

No wonder the Bible says *"we are members of His body, of His flesh and of His bones"* (Ephesians 5:30). This means the life of Christ is flowing through you in real ways, even when you're doing homework, hanging out with friends, or playing sports. Christ literally lives in you! He dwells in your spirit and expresses Himself through your physical body. This is why sickness, disease, and weakness ought not to thrive in your physical body. When you're conscious of this truth that Christ lives in you, it'll be impossible for you to experience any infirmity!

The reason many have suffered so much trouble

in their health is their lack of knowledge. According to the provisions of the Gospel, it ought not to be possible for any child of God to be sick or suffer affliction of any kind. Your body isn't ordinary; it's Christ's expression point on earth; Christ rules and functions in your physical body. Meditate on this truth and let it gain the ascendancy in your spirit. Live with the daily consciousness that your body is a member of Christ. As you do, sin, sickness, and disease will be completely banished from your life.

My body is a member of Christ; therefore, the life and nature of Christ is manifested in me. Sickness, sin, and death can find no place or expression in my physical body, for my body is the temple of the Holy Spirit. 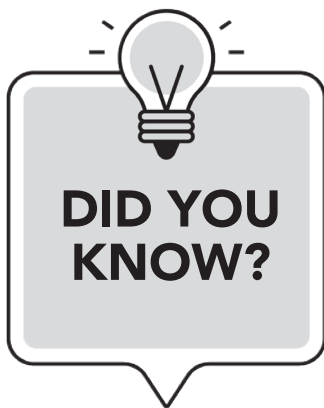

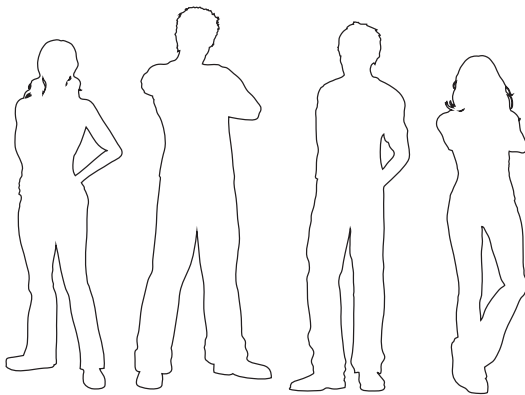


YOUR MOBILE PHONE

(The Confident Leap on
God's Word)

TO THE BIBLE - Hebrews 11:1

"Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen."

LET'S TALK



Liam: "I don't know... I just feel like if I try to pray
over this test, it won't make a difference."

Ava: "Why not? God's Word says He'll guide your
steps. Faith isn't guessing or hoping; it's trusting His Word."

Liam: "But what if it doesn't work?"

Ava: "Then it was not faith, because faith ALWAYS
WORKS."

Faith isn't a leap in the dark as some people think, but a leap on the Word of God. Understanding this simple truth will position you rightly to live triumphantly every day and help you judge whether you're actually functioning in faith or not. Those who think faith is a mysterious leap in the dark are always apprehensive and reluctant to take the step that'd have led them to victory. They're always hesitating over stuff like exams, school projects, or standing up for what's right: "What if I fail the test?" "What if I try to help my friend and it doesn't work out?" "What if I speak the Word and nothing changes?" That shouldn't be you.

Faith is the confident assurance that, based on God's Word, things favourably expected will come to pass. Faith doesn't ask "what if?" Rather, faith knows. In other words, faith knows that if hands are laid on the sick, they'll recover, since that's what the Word says! Faith knows that if there's a need, then there'll definitely be a corresponding supply based on Philippians 4:19: *"And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus."*

Hallelujah!

If you see faith as a leap into the unknown, you'll always have many reasons for not doing the things you ought to do. You'll always find yourself considering, reconsidering and hesitating. Faith depends on the Word of God as the basis and assurance for action. Faith hears and jumps, but fear hears the same thing and considers other factors. Remember, in the eyes of natural men, the Word of God is "unreasonable"; it makes no sense. That's because God's Word isn't meant for the head but for the human spirit. Learn to respond to God's Word from your spirit, and your faith will always prevail.

CARNAL OR SPIRITUAL?

(Discover the Difference and Grow in God)

TO THE BIBLE - 1 Corinthians 3:1

"And I, brethren, could not speak to you as to spiritual people but as to carnal, as to babes in Christ."

LET'S TALK



Grafting is an agricultural technique where a branch (or scion) from one tree is joined to the rootstock of another.

That branch then draws nutrients from the new root system to which it is attached and begins producing fruit with better qualities as a result. However, if the grafting isn't complete, the branch might still try to produce its original less desirable fruit or fail to thrive entirely. The key is that the connection to the new root system must be fully established.

The Bible reveals two categories of Christians: the spiritual and the carnal. As the Apostle Paul wrote to the Corinthians: *"for you are still carnal. For where there are envy, strife, and divisions among you, are you not carnal and behaving like mere men?"* (1 Corinthians 3:3). In other words, they weren't spiritually mature. Their lives weren't governed by the Word of God. Meanwhile, the spiritual Christian is the one whose life is regulated by the Word; he's not just a hearer but a doer of the Word. He holds God's Word as the final authority in his life.

These two classes of Christians exist in the Church today: the carnal Christian and the spiritual Christian. The carnal Christians are easy to spot: they gossip, fight, or act like everyone else online, even though they're supposed to be following Jesus. As a newborn babe in Christ, you may find yourself still speaking the language of the people of the world, since you're still growing in the knowledge of God's

Word; however, to remain at that babyhood stage is unacceptable. Some folks in the Church still talk worldly, months and even years after coming to Christ; they're the ones Paul refers to as "carnal."

He further highlighted the characteristic of the carnal Christians: Carnal Christians walk in jealousy and live like unbelievers because they lack understanding of spiritual things. But in contrast, the spiritual Christian has matured in God's Word. They live it out in school, at home, and even on social media; they speak the Word, make choices based on it, and stand out for the right reasons. That should be you.

The words “Thank you” are two of the most powerful words you can ever say. They’re words that convey heartfelt appreciation and gratefulness, which, when rightly expressed, leave in the heart of the recipient an indelible impression of your sincere gratitude. Sadly, some people find it difficult to say “Thank you” even when the occasion warrants it. As a Christian, it matters that you express gratitude and manifest a grateful spirit at all times.

Did you ever go out somewhere and an usher showed you to a seat in church or at the theatre, and you sat down without saying, “Thank you”? Did a cab driver drive you safely to your destination, and you alighted without saying “Thank you”? Have you ever been in school and a classmate shared their notes with you before a test, and you just collected them and walked off? All of these are simple, everyday situations we experience, and sometimes we don’t realise we ought to be thankful for these little things.

God expects you to have an attitude of gratitude; therefore, you should always be quick to say “Thank you.” When people do things for you, be it a favour or even something they’re obliged to do, always remember to thank them for it. Train yourself to lavishly express gratitude. Let that joyful atmosphere of thanksgiving always fill your

home! There's so much in life to be grateful for; so, practise being thankful.

Every day, before you think of your long list of prayer requests, thank God for all that He's already done! When you learn to express gratitude to God, and profusely thank people for what they do for you, you'll be amazed at the favour, joy and promotion you'll experience in your life.

Some people are more concerned about keeping their bodies fit instead of paying the most attention to exercising their spirit unto godliness. The spirit is the real man; no wonder we're admonished in the Scripture to exercise ourselves rather unto godliness (1 Timothy 4:7).

God doesn't want you to have a super-built body and be flabby spiritually; therefore, you must exercise your spirit! You must engage in spiritual exercise, which, unlike physical exercise, has a promise both for this life and for the life to come. So, the question then is: how do you exercise yourself spiritually? It's simply by engaging in spiritual activities, such as going to church regularly, praying in tongues consistently, studying God's Word and sharing it with others.

Some young people only show up to church when they feel like it or when their friends are going, and that's not right. "Pursue love, and desire spiritual gifts, but especially that you may prophesy."

LET'S TALK



The Bible says, *"There are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit"* (1 Corinthians 12:4), meaning that there are several gifts that God imparts to His children through the agency of the Holy Spirit. But from our opening Scripture, we can decipher that the gift of prophecy ranks above all the other gifts of the Spirit that you should desire. God wants you to operate the gift of prophecy.

The gift of prophecy isn't just for apostles, prophets, evangelists or pastors; it's for the Church! Every Christian ought to prophesy. To prophesy is to speak forth the Word of God in power, whether by foretelling future events, or as a rhema-word to cause a change in the now! The Bible says, *"But he who prophesies speaks edification and exhortation and comfort to men. He who speaks in a tongue edifies himself, but he who prophesies edifies the church"* (1 Corinthians 14:3-4). When you declare the mind of God in prophecy, others are edified, strengthened and comforted.

Thus, with the gift of prophecy in operation in your life, you can never be in darkness as to what steps to take in life. Whether it's choosing which subjects to focus on, navigating friendships, or making plans for your future, prophecy can guide you. Moses, in the Old Testament, understood the power and importance of prophecy and wished that all of God's children were prophets (Numbers 11:29). But thanks be unto God; now that we're born again and have received the Holy Spirit, we've received the divine

enablement and inspiration to prophesy. Hallelujah!

Consequently, whether you're praying on your own or in the company of other Christians, you can prophesy. As the Word of God wells up in you under that influence of the Holy Spirit, open your mouth and speak forth those words in prophecy. Begin to desire the gift of prophecy. The Bible says the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man (not some but all) to profit withal (1 Corinthians 12:7). This means you, too, can prophesy, and you can begin right now! Hallelujah!

LET'S TALK



As a child of God, you must be very definite about your commitment to Christ. The Lord Jesus made it abundantly clear that there can be no middle ground when it comes to expressing your allegiance to Him; it's got to be all or nothing. He meant it when He said, *"...whoever denies Me before men, him I will also deny before My Father who is in heaven."*

Some people deny Jesus sometimes without knowing it. For example, at school, someone might mockingly ask, "Wait, are you seriously one of those 'church kids'?" and to protect your social image, you might laugh it off or give a vague answer like, "I just go sometimes." You may not know it, but you just missed a big opportunity to identify with Jesus. You ought to have boldly declared, "Yes! I follow Jesus!" Some young people hide their Bibles in their backpacks when they're at school or with friends, so people won't ask questions; that's wrong. The most honourable, sublime and worthy personality you could ever be identified with is the Lord Jesus. Be proud of your association with Him and those for whom He died. Never tuck your head in shame when those who are unlearned in the things of God make derogatory remarks about Christians and what

they believe. Be proud of your identity as a born-again, Spirit-filled, tongue-talking child of God.

Nothing in this world is worth clinging to at the expense of your commitment to Christ. There's no greater honour than to belong to the Lord Jesus Christ! Stand up tall for him everywhere you are and let others know that you're a Christian. When you do, He too will speak on your behalf.

TO THE BIBLE - Colossians 2:2-3

"that their hearts may be encouraged, being knit together in love, and attaining to all riches of the full assurance of understanding, to the knowledge of the mystery of God, both of the Father and of Christ, in whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge."

LET'S TALK



The Bible says all of the treasures of wisdom and knowledge are hidden in Christ, and we know that Christ in the context of the scripture above doesn't refer to Jesus alone: *"so we, being many, are one body in Christ, and individually members of one another"* (Romans 12:5). In other words, Christ refers to the Church for which Jesus is the Head, and we're His body. Thus, if all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge are hid in Christ, that means nothing ought to be beyond your scope of knowledge as a child of God.

Let me give you a practical example: You might have lost something, like your earphones or a textbook, and you've turned your room upside down looking for it; you've exhausted every logical thought. But do you know that your spirit doesn't forget? If you activate your spirit by speaking in tongues, your spirit will begin to function like a GPS! Before long, your spirit sends that signal to your mind, and you know where that thing is. Someone may ask, "Does this really work?" Emphatically, yes! The reason some of God's people still function below their call is ignorance; they haven't tapped into the reservoir of knowledge God has made available to them. No child of God should be in

the dark about anything. Should you need insight for a school project, wisdom for a relationship, or clarity for a decision, through the agency of the Holy Spirit, you can access knowledge of any topic in the world.

Begin to practise how to relate with God's treasure-house of knowledge through the Spirit. The next time you're tempted to say, "I don't know thus and thus," stop yourself and say, "In the Name of Jesus, I have access to the treasures of wisdom and knowledge!" Then, begin to speak in tongues and let the Holy Spirit bring that knowledge home to your spirit and then to your mind, for you have access to all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge. Glory to God!

TO THE BIBLE - Ephesians 5:18

"And do not be drunk with wine, in which is dissipation; but be filled with the Spirit."

LET'S TALK



Reading our opening verse above in the Amplified Classic makes it clearer; it says, *"And do not get drunk with wine, for that is debauchery; but ever be filled and stimulated with the [Holy] Spirit."* The fact that you've received the Holy Spirit doesn't mean you're always filled with the Spirit. To be filled with the Spirit doesn't mean you've lost your mind, as some people think! It means you're functioning under the control and influence of the Holy Spirit twenty-four hours every day. That's how God wants you to live.

Note that you don't get filled with the Spirit simply because you said, "I'm now filled with the Spirit." There are things you do that fill you with the Spirit, and they're listed in the nineteenth verse: *"speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord"* (Ephesians 5:19). This is how to be filled with the Spirit.

"Psalms" are spiritual poems sung or spoken to God in worship. "Hymns" are songs of thanksgiving and praise directed to God or about God. "Spiritual songs" are prophetic songs that come to you from the realm of the Spirit. Such songs are filled with the Word of God, and sometimes they may come to you in other tongues. Then he says to "Make melody in your heart to the Lord." The melody might be you humming a tune to God while you walk to class or wait for the bus, but you're getting so blessed as you sing to the

Lord in your own heart!

Never leave home or embark on any endeavour without being filled with the Spirit. A good way to get yourself in the flow of the Spirit before a big day at school, preaching the Gospel, or a sports game is to start by speaking in other tongues as you get ready. Before long, the words and songs of the Spirit will well up in you. You can't be filled with the Spirit and experience sickness, failure, or lack. Your spirit will continually be energised for victory and success every day.

TO THE BIBLE - John 8:12

"Then Jesus spoke to them again, saying, 'I am the light of the world. He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but have the light of life.'"

LET'S TALK



In our opening scripture above, Jesus said, *"I am the light of the world,"* and that's quite remarkable! He didn't say, "I have a light for the world," or "I know of a special light somewhere for the world." He said, *"I am the light of the world. He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but have the light of life"*. Period.

John described Him as *"...the true Light which gives light to every man coming into the world"* (John 1:9). There are other lights in the world, but Jesus is the true light! As long as you've received Him into your heart and follow Him, you'll never again walk in darkness. Why is that? It's because the true light now shines from within you.

Now, what's light? Light is that which describes; in other words, it shows you what exists. If you entered a pitch-dark room with no flicker of light, even though that room may be beautifully adorned with state-of-the-art décor, furniture, and electronic gadgets, it would be impossible for you to see and appreciate their beauty. That's because there's no light describing or showing you the things present in that room.

In the same way, young people who don't have Jesus in their lives can't know what true success, fulfilment, peace

and prosperity are. Such people grope in darkness, and in utter hopelessness—journeying aimlessly, with a ticket to nowhere. Restless will they be until they find their rest in Christ Jesus, who is the True Light that lights every man. He'll light your life with success, peace, health, joy, and prosperity. Glory to God!

LET'S TALK



Someone offers you a choice: they could deposit a million dollars into your bank account right now, OR they could give you the wisdom to know how to create, manage, and multiply wealth for your entire life. Which would you pick: the million dollars or wisdom?

Are you still thinking about which one to go for? The principal thing you need for success in life is divine wisdom. Yes. David knew this, and he admonished his son Solomon on the importance of prizing wisdom over riches. He said, *"Wisdom is the principal thing; therefore get wisdom. And in all your getting, get understanding"* (Proverbs 4:7). He had known from his walk with God that wisdom was the key thing in life, and he passed that on to his son Solomon. It was no surprise, therefore, that when God asked Solomon what he wanted Him to do for him (1 Kings 3:5), Solomon said, *"Therefore give to Your servant an understanding heart to judge Your people, that I may discern between good and evil..."* (1 Kings 3:9). In other words, he asked for wisdom.

The Lord's response to Solomon's request was remarkable. He said, *"Because you have asked this thing, and have not asked long life for yourself, nor have asked riches for yourself, nor have asked the life of your enemies, but have asked for yourself understanding to discern justice, behold, I have done according to your words; see, I have given you*

a wise and understanding heart... And I have also given you what you have not asked: both riches and honor, so that there shall not be anyone like you among the kings all your days" (1 Kings 3:11-13). For choosing wisdom, rather than riches, Solomon became the wealthiest man who lived until Jesus. Why? Because wisdom will deliver riches to you!

As you imbibe God's Word into you, not only will you find yourself dealing wisely in the affairs of life (like choosing the right friends, handling pressure at school, or making good decisions), but wealth and riches beyond your comprehension will be delivered into your hands! You wouldn't have to ask or pray for them. Don't pursue money, fame or material possessions. Go for wisdom!

LET'S TALK



In teaching the disciples how to pray, the Lord Jesus gave them a format; He said, *"In this manner, therefore, pray: Our Father in heaven, Hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come..."* (Matthew 6:9-10). He taught them to pray in expectation of the coming Kingdom of God because at the time, He hadn't died, and the world was being dominated by another kingdom, which is the kingdom of darkness.

However, after His death, burial, and resurrection, when He met His disciples, His message to them changed. He said to them: *"All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations..."* (Matthew 28:18-19). All the authority in the universe was vested in Jesus, and He's given us that authority as His Kingdom representatives. He wants you to go ahead and manifest His kingdom to the world. No wonder He said in Luke 17:21: *"...indeed, the kingdom of God is within you."* There's no need to pray for the Kingdom to come anymore, for that prayer has been answered in us, the new creation.

If you're born again, you've become the carrier of the Kingdom of God; the Kingdom is in you! When you walk into your school, your home, or your sports practice, it means God's Kingdom has arrived there. Hallelujah! The

world has suffered for too long from the influence of Satan's kingdom, and it's up to us now to dominate this world with the principles of God's Kingdom.

Rise to your calling as a kingdom-carrier; don't allow the devil to run things around you. You've been given the highest authority in the universe, the Name of Jesus, to use in ruling over the devil and negative circumstances. You can put a stop to sickness, war, death, poverty and all the other corrupting influences of the kingdom of darkness. You can superimpose peace, righteousness, love, joy, health and prosperity in your own sphere of contact. Glory to God!

TO THE BIBLE - Hebrews 11:1

"Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen."

LET'S TALK



Faith, the Bible says, is the substance of what you hope for, and the title-deed of unseen realities. In other words, faith means that the things you were hoping for are now your present-hour possession. This is where the demonstration of faith comes into play. If it's true that what you hoped for is now yours, then you ought to act that way. For example, you might have prayed to God for something concerning yourself, believing He'd do it.

If you truly believe that God heard your prayer, then you shouldn't come back tomorrow and pray about the same thing again. You should now begin to act like someone who has received from God: that's how to put your faith to work. That's what Marcus' Dad is saying in the opening conversation.

When Peter and John met the crippled man at the gate of the temple called Beautiful, Peter said to the man, *"Silver and gold I do not have, but what I do have I give you: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, rise up and walk"* (Acts 3:6). Peter then grabbed the man by the hand, and lifted him. The Bible says, *"So he, leaping up, stood and walked and entered the temple with them—walking, leaping, and praising God"* (Acts 3:8).

The man didn't try to test whether he could stand up; he jumped up! That's a demonstration of faith. He believed he'd been healed, and he immediately acted that way, and he began to walk instantly. Understand that faith is active and not passive; faith acts now because it's taken possession. That's why the Bible says, "*... faith by itself, if it does not have works, is dead*" (James 2:17). That means faith without corresponding actions is dead. The faith that works is when you believe that what God says is yours is yours, and then you act accordingly.

TO THE BIBLE - Galatians 5:13

"For you, brethren, have been called to liberty; only do not use liberty as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another."

LET'S TALK



When you were born again, you were born into a life of absolute liberty in Christ. You became free to live, free to serve God, free to reign and free to love. However, as Christians, the Bible admonishes us to use our liberty in Christ rightly. Under the Old Testament, they could read the commandments to know what to do and what not to do, but the new creation man wasn't given any law to obey: *"knowing this: that the law is not made for a righteous person, but for the lawless and insubordinate, for the ungodly and for sinners, for the unholy and profane, for murderers of fathers and murderers of mothers, for manslayers"* (1 Timothy 1:9).

According to the Bible, it's difficult to impute sin where there's no law (Romans 4:15). Some young Christians are in a dilemma because they've been brought into a life without a list of religious rules. So, they might think, "I'm free; so I can do whatever I want and get away with it." The Bible says, *"as free, yet not using liberty as a cloak for vice, but as bondservants of God"* (1 Peter 2:16).

The life you live as a child of God should be to the praise and glory of God in all things. Though it's absolutely clear that God has called you to a free life, only make sure that you don't use this freedom as an excuse to do whatever you want to do and destroy your freedom. Rather, use your

freedom to serve one another in love; that's how freedom grows (Galatians 5:13).

Use your liberty in Christ rightly by doing only those things that please the Father; and the way to please the Father is to walk by faith, which, by extension, is to walk according to the provisions of God's Word. Yes, God isn't imposing rules and regulations on us like a strict principal with a rulebook; He's given us His Word as a guide. But be sure to use your liberty to the praise and glory of His Name.

LET'S TALK



When God arises in a person's life, all enemies are scattered, and all that hate Him flee in terror! But how does God arise in your life? Is it just by praying, "O God, arise; defeat my enemies"? What you do matters. Firstly, notice the words "Let God arise"; that's another way of saying, "Allow God to arise." It's your choice to let Him move in your life. Since God and His Word are one: *"In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God"* (John 1:1), giving His Word first place in your life lets Him arise.

God doesn't need to part the heavens to work in you; He already lives inside you. As you meditate on His Word and speak in tongues, His Word stirs in your spirit. That's God arising in you! Then speak that Word as a prophecy. No enemy can resist it. When life throws challenges—like school stress, peer pressure, or feeling left out—don't just feel stuck. Stir God's Word in your spirit and speak it out. Say, "I've got the power of God in me! I'm stronger than any challenge! I'm set up for success, happiness, and peace!" Doing this makes fear, doubt, and negativity back off.

Keep declaring: "I have the life of God in me! I can

never be poor! Prosperity, health, and goodness are my birthright!" As you do, poverty, sickness, lack, and failure will flee. Your faith in God through His Word will rise like a giant and defeat every enemy in your life.

"Who being the brightness of His glory and the express image of His person, and upholding all things by the word of His power, when He had by Himself purged our sins, sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high" (Hebrews 1:3).

Brightness is an attribute of visual perception in which a source appears to radiate or reflect light. In other words, brightness is the perception elicited by the luminance of a visual target. It's the subjective attribute or property of an object being observed; the quality or state of being bright. It derives from the Greek word "apaugasma," which means effulgence. It refers to radiant splendour, brilliance, a perfect replica of beauty.

Thus, Jesus being the brightness of God's glory means He's the effulgence, the radiant splendour, brilliance, and perfect replica of His beauty. Since the Christian is born after the similitude of the Second Adam, the Lord Jesus, it follows that he shares this same likeness, being the effulgence of God's glory.

As a Christian, you're the out-showing of God's glory. You're the perfection of beauty; the fullness of God and the totality of His power dwell in you. So, you're complete in Him (Colossians 2:10).

LET'S TALK



Filters are designed to allow only the good parts of a solution or mixture to pass through, while the undesirable parts are caught and held back. That's the same principle the Spirit of God shows us in our opening scripture. Your mind is the door to your spirit, and whatever thoughts or words you allow through will shape your spirit. That's why you need to screen and filter what enters your heart.

Every day, we hear and see all kinds of information, positive and negative. You need a spiritual filter: guard your heart and refuse to process anything that doesn't line up with God's Word. For example, if someone says, "Life is impossible for teens like us," or you hear bad news about the economy, don't let those words define you. Remind yourself: "God has great plans for me, and I walk in His blessings."

Use the Word of God as your filter to stop wrong thoughts from taking root in your heart. Whatever life you're living now comes from your thoughts and words. The Bible says, *"And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind...."* (Romans 12:2). Transformation starts with your thought patterns. Reject fear, lack, or negativity. Instead, focus on success in school, relationships, talents, and joy that

comes from God’s Word.

Choose thoughts of victory, health, prosperity, happiness, and fulfilment—whatever aligns with God’s Word. Every time you scroll, watch a video, or listen to someone, ask: “Does this encourage God’s truth or plant fear?” Let His Word guide what you accept. Keep vigilant watch over your heart because what you allow in will shape who you become.

LET'S TALK



"Do you ever feel like you're just... ordinary?" Khloe asked, frowning.

"Ordinary? Not at all," replied Johnny. "God has put special abilities in you that no one else can express the way you can."

Khloe looked puzzled: "Special abilities? Me? I've never really thought of myself that way."

"That's exactly why you need to hear this," Johnny said with a smile. "No one was ever like you; no one is like you, and no one will ever be like you. You're the only one of you that God has. So, be the best of you."

The Living Bible translation renders our opening scripture this way: *"However, Christ has given each of us special abilities; whatever He wants us to have out of His rich storehouse of gifts."* I like that term, "special abilities," for it lets us know that there's not a single one of God's children that's lacking in ability. You may never have thought about the fact that God has given you special abilities, but let it dawn on you today that there are special abilities in you which came into your life when you were born again and received the Holy Spirit.

The Bible says, *"But you shall receive power (ability, efficiency, and might) when the Holy Spirit has come upon you"* (Acts 1:8 AMP). What you need do is recognise and agree with what the Word says; tell yourself, "God has given me special abilities, and I'm putting these abilities to work in my life."

Remember that God doesn't have a duplicate of you; He's deposited in you gifts and abilities that set you apart and make you unique. What a wonderful blessing! You can express the beauty of God from your spirit in a way that no one else can. So, next time you feel like you're just "another face in the crowd" at school or on social media, remember: God made you with a one-of-a-kind mix of abilities that no one else has. Stop comparing your story to someone else's story!

Never look at yourself and think there's nothing special about you. God has given you special abilities, and it's up to you to let them show and make an impact in the Kingdom of God.

LET'S TALK

The Lord Jesus made it clear that it's not how much you receive and amass that measures your value. Rather, you measure your value or worth by how much you give. No wonder the Apostle Paul, reiterating the words of the Master, declared that *"...it is more blessed to give than to receive"* (Acts 20:35). As far as God is concerned, the one who gives is greater than the one who receives. Thus, it's not how much you have in your bank account that determines your worth; rather, it's how much you give.

The only way to conquer anything, be it money or some other material possession, is by giving it. That means it's not about how many sneakers you own, how much allowance you get, or how many gadgets you have; if you can't give it, you don't really have control over it; it has control over you. If you ever find that you're unable to give something you possess, it means you haven't conquered that thing yet. But when you're able to exercise your faith and give it, you've conquered that level, and immediately, God promotes you to a higher level of giving.

Learn to be a giver. Nothing of this world should have a hold over you to the point that you can't give it. The Lord Jesus said, *"Give, and it will be given to you: good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over will be put into your bosom. For with the same measure that you use, it will be measured back to you"* (Luke 6:38).

That means the giver has a promise; a guarantee that he'll only move upward and forward in life. But for the receiver, there's no promise.

Therefore, make up your mind to be a giver. Decide now—even as a teenager—that you'll be known as someone who gives generously, not just someone who always wants more. As you learn to release, God will multiply your seeds sown and increase your ability, such that you'll keep getting greater and greater.

LET'S TALK



The most sublime and profound communication ever to proceed from anyone came from the lips of Jesus. The Jews in His day couldn't comprehend the wisdom and audacity with which the Master spoke. That's because He communicated with a spiritual language while they were men and women of the senses. For example, when He said in the scripture above, *"...I am from above,"* He wasn't referring to a physical life. He was referring to a spiritual life!

Jesus knew that His life didn't come from Mary, because He was the Word of God made flesh. Conscious of that reality, He could say with boldness that He wasn't of this world. Now, the Bible says concerning us that as He (Jesus) is, so are we in this world (1 John 4:17). If you're born again, you're no longer an ordinary person; you're from above just as Jesus is, and you have the same indestructible life that He has.

The Bible says we've been born again *"...not of corruptible seed but incorruptible, through the word of God which lives and abides forever"* (1 Peter 1:23). You've been born again of that same living Word, which came from heaven, which means you too can declare like Jesus, "I'm from above!" That means your identity isn't defined by your school, your background, your mistakes, or what people say about you. Hallelujah! I would to God every Christian would live with this consciousness. It'll change everything about them and bring a supernatural perspective to their lives! Don't think like the rest of the world. Yes, you may look like them physically, but the life in you is from above.

Train yourself in this consciousness. Speak a different language: the language of the Kingdom that you're from. Refuse to speak sickness, disease, lack, and failure. They're not part of your heavenly kingdom. Refuse to say things like, "I'm just not good enough," "I'm not sure I'm going to succeed," or "I'm always anxious." That's not the language of someone who's from above. For example, it doesn't matter that others around you are catching the flu; you're from above; the life in you destroys and casts out the flu.

I encourage you to carry this consciousness into your classrooms, onto the sports field, into group chats, everywhere you go, and even on social media. When you open your mouth to speak, others may think you're out of your mind, or you're being boastful (like they thought of Jesus), but that shouldn't change your confession of who you are: you're from above! Glory to God!

PUT IT ON!

(Stand Firm With The Whole
Armour Of God)

TO THE BIBLE - Ephesians 6:11

"Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil."

LET'S TALK



In our fight of faith, the Bible says, *"We do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places"* (Ephesians 6:12). This means your real battles aren't with people—like classmates, friends, or family—but spiritual forces working behind the scenes. That's why we're then enjoined to put on the whole armour of God.

Now, did you notice the Scripture doesn't say, "Pray that God would put the armour on you"? It says you're the one to put it on. So, it's no use praying and crying to God to protect you from the wiles of the devil; He's told you what to do: put on the armour of God. Also, the Scripture emphasises that you should put on the **WHOLE** armour of God, not just some of it. Another version says, *"Put on the complete armor of God..."* (WNT).

I like the word "complete". You've got to make sure that you don't leave any part of that armour out. So, it's up to you to have your loins covered with truth, righteousness as your breastplate, to have on your feet the Gospel of peace, the helmet of salvation, and then the one he says you should put on above all the others is the shield of faith. Just like you wouldn't go to school without everything you need for the day, you shouldn't face life without every piece

of God's armour.

We've been given a shield to extinguish all the fiery darts of the devil. Those fiery darts can show up as fear, insecurity, peer pressure, or thoughts that tell you you're not good enough. The armour of God is available to you today, but you have to make a conscious choice to put it on. God isn't going to put it on for you, no matter how much you pray and fast for Him to.

You decide daily to stand for truth, choose faith over fear, and live right, even when it's not popular. Stand firmly with your whole armour on as a good soldier of Christ. And remember, as you put it on, make sure you keep it on at all times; don't ever take it off!

TO THE BIBLE - Matthew 9:28

"And when He had come into the house, the blind men came to Him. And Jesus said to them, 'Do you believe that I am able to do this?' They said to Him, 'Yes, Lord.'"

LET'S TALK



A man came to Jesus one day to ask the Master to heal his demon-possessed son. The man said to Jesus, *"If You can do anything, have compassion on us and help us"* (Mark 9:22b). The Master replied, *"If you can believe, all things are possible to him who believes"* (Mark 9:23). Finally, the man blurted out, *"Lord, I believe; help my unbelief"* (Mark 9:24)! He was trying to put the responsibility for his believing on Jesus, which shouldn't be. The Lord, nonetheless, compassionately healed the boy.

Many people are like that man today. They think that if they're unbelieving, it's up to God to help them believe, but it's not so. The Bible says, *"...with the heart one believes unto righteousness..."* (Romans 10:10). You believe with your heart. This means that believing is a choice, which is entirely up to you; it's your responsibility to believe. God isn't the one to make you believe His Word. You're the one to choose to believe His Word, and when you do, you'll see His glory in your life (John 11:40).

God is looking for someone who can believe! Every time He locates such a person, He does mighty things in his life. Abraham believed God and received a son in his old age. Moses believed God and led more than six million Jews through the midst of the Red Sea. He's looking for those

who can stake their lives on His Word.

Make a choice today to believe; cast yourself on His Word, trusting that everything the Lord has said is true. Your dreams—whether it’s getting into the right school, acquiring a scholarship, or becoming who God has called you to be—are possible if only you can believe. Praise God!

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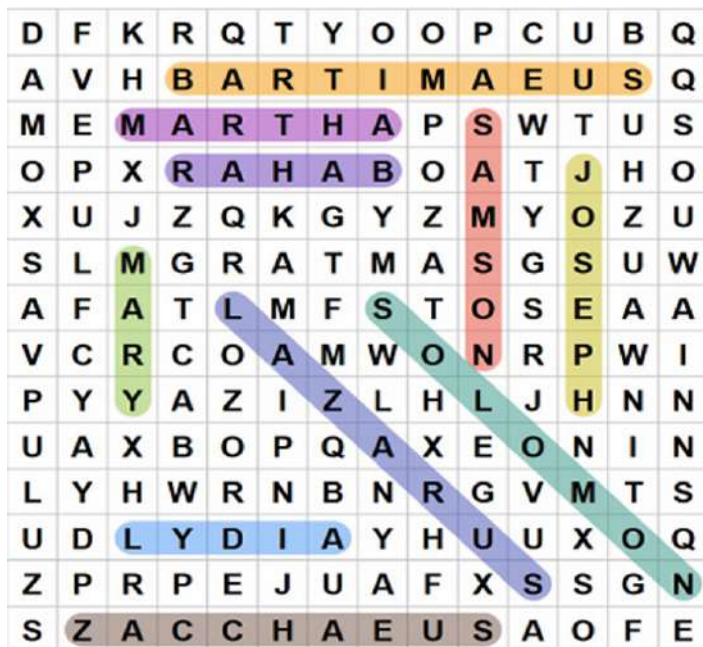
